## TOWN OF PROVOST

### FRANCHISE FEE INCREASE NOTICE

Please be advised that the Town of Provost is proposing to increase the local access fee, which is charged to FortisAlberta Inc. (FortisAlberta) for use of municipal lands for its power lines effective January 1, 2009. The fee is recovered by FortisAlberta from its customers as the local access fee on electric billings of all customers that receive electric service in the Town of Provost.

The local access fee will be increased from 8% to 10% of the delivery charge of FortisAlberta excluding energy related riders. The average residential increase has been estimated at 59 cents per month.
