Scarecrows in downtown Provost and elsewhere should soon be popping up as the Provost and District Chamber of Commerce is sponsoring a contest that will tie in with this year's Pumpkin Festival competition.

was first suggested by Warren Schug (see PN Sept. 17) who is heading the Dennis Schug Memorial pumpkin growing contest—but says he just had-

n't the time to organize it.

The contest idea was brought up at the latest Provost and District Chamber of Commerce meeting and a committee quickly formed which came up with details for the fun event.

Anyone can build or even purchase a scarecrow and put it on display in the Communities in Bloom barrels along Main Street. Those barrels were cleaned out of flowers on Saturday which now makes way for the new creatures to inhabit.

Because the scarecrows can also be displayed at home or elsewhere in town, one of the organizers, Bert Roach

says that people should register them all so they can be found for judging.

The Provost and District Chamber of Commerce is awarding \$100 for first place, \$60 for second and \$40 for third.

The top three creative creations will be displayed at the Agriplex in Provost at the pumpkin festival on Friday, October 10.

There is no entry fee and scarecrows can be put up immediately with judges from residents of Hillcrest Lodge to inspect the entries on Thursday, October 9. (More details inside this paper).

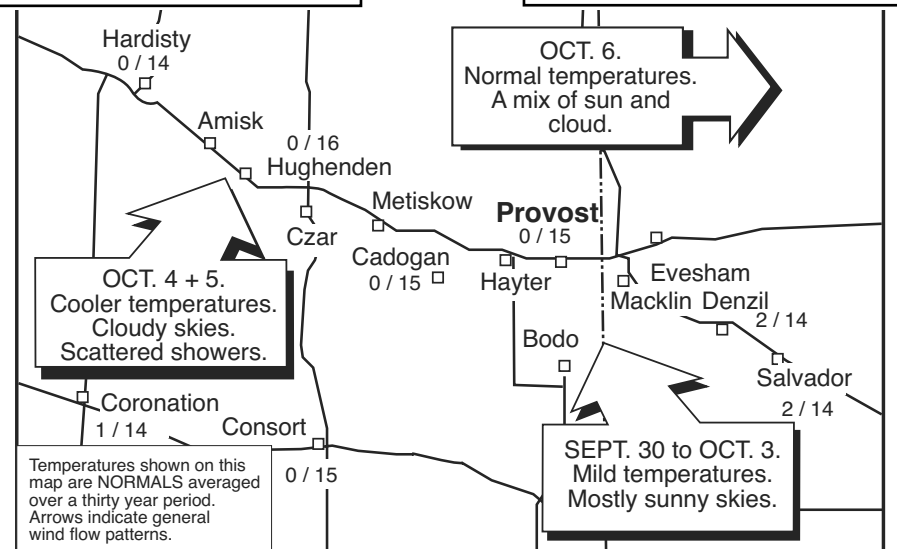
